What is Server+? CompTIA's Server+ certification is an international industry credential that validates the knowledge of individuals with 18-24 months experience with Industry Standard Server Architecture (ISSA) technology. Professionals who want to certify their advanced technical knowledge in such areas as RAID, SCSI, multiple CPUs and the like, should consider this certification. While Server+ does not require CompTIA's A+ certification as a prerequisite, either this certification or similar is recommended. The skills and knowledge measured by this examination were developed with global input to assure accuracy, validity and reliability.

Exam Focus

Earning the Server+ designation means that the candidate can install, configure, diagnose and troubleshoot server hardware and network operating systems. The Server+ exam establishes an individual's knowledge of ISSA hardware skills in such areas as RAID, SCSI, multiple CPUs and the like, on Intel and other ISSA-based systems.

The exam tests seven areas of knowledge and the extent to which they are represented is shown in parentheses:

- Installation (17%)
- Configuration (18%)
- Upgrading (12%)
- Proactive Maintenance (9%)
- Environment (5%)
- Troubleshooting (27%)
- Disaster Recovery (12%)
