

## **DAVID A. TURNER**



David A. Turner is the Acting Director of the Office of Space Affairs within the U.S. State Department, where he manages a broad portfolio of bilateral and multilateral civil space activities, including the development and implementation of national space policy and strategy, and international affairs focused on the civil and commercial space sectors. He was the Deputy Director of the same office from 2008 to March 2020.

Previously, Mr. Turner was an employee of the Aerospace Corporation, the U.S. Department of Commerce, and the National Academies/National Research Council (NRC), and was a consultant with the Congressional Research Service while earning a Masters degree through the George Washington University Space Policy Institute.

Lieutenant Colonel (ret.) Turner also served in the U.S. Air Force, Air Force Reserve, and Air National Guard from 1986 to 2014 as a C-130 Navigator, Airlift Command & Control Officer, Chief of Command Post, and Air Operations Executive Officer.
